Action taken on Student Feedback

The Governing body of the college has taken the necessary initiative for engagement of teachers for such departments so that syllabus could be completed in a timebound manner in such departments like Philosophy.

The governing body took the necessary initiative so that arrangement of tours and excursions could be done in future.

The student response in this parameter is more or less evenly distributed. The introduction of ICT tools, LMS and learning resources for students are required so that all the students may get the advantage equally. Action taken: The governing body decided on further enhancing these facilities for students.

Tutorial classes are allotted in the routine. The plan to introduce mentor-mentee programme was discussed in the academic committee

The response shows that majority of the students are not satisfied with the existing library. Action taken: The matter was taken up in the governing body and the necessary initiatives including allotment of fund is done for the modernization of library.

Necessary initiatives are taken for building of additional classrooms and other necessary facilities in the college.

Alumni

Initiatives are taken through proper channel for augmentation, maintenance and upgradation of the existing infrastructure. Physical infrastructure is developed through building additional classrooms and other amenities to nurture more modernized academic ambience in the college.

All necessary initiatives are taken to step up the development process of the college. The requisition for the approval of grant is submitted through proper channel.

The Governing Body decided on 12.07.2023 that an academic diary be maintained to better navigate the teaching-learning processes at the college.

The Governing Body resolved on 30.04.2022 that a separate budget of Rs. 25000 be allocated for the purpose of research for the FY 2022-2023.

: On a Governing Body meeting dated, 30.01.2023 it was decided to include State Aided College Teachers in different sub-committees of the college.

Requisition for a Librarian and proposal for Digitization of Library was made to the West Bengal College Service Commission on as per Governing Body Resolution taken on 05.08.2022. Another requisition made on Governing Body decision, taken on 04.04.2023.

: Governing Body decided on 14.03.2022 to engage a new Jamadar on temporary basis on daily wages to clean toilets and bathrooms, at least thrice a week, preferably alternate day

Governing Body deliberated on interviewing new canteen vendors, as on 30.01.2023 and approved agreement terms for the canteen vendor. Another Governing Body Meeting on 07.08.2023 suggests canteen should reopen.
