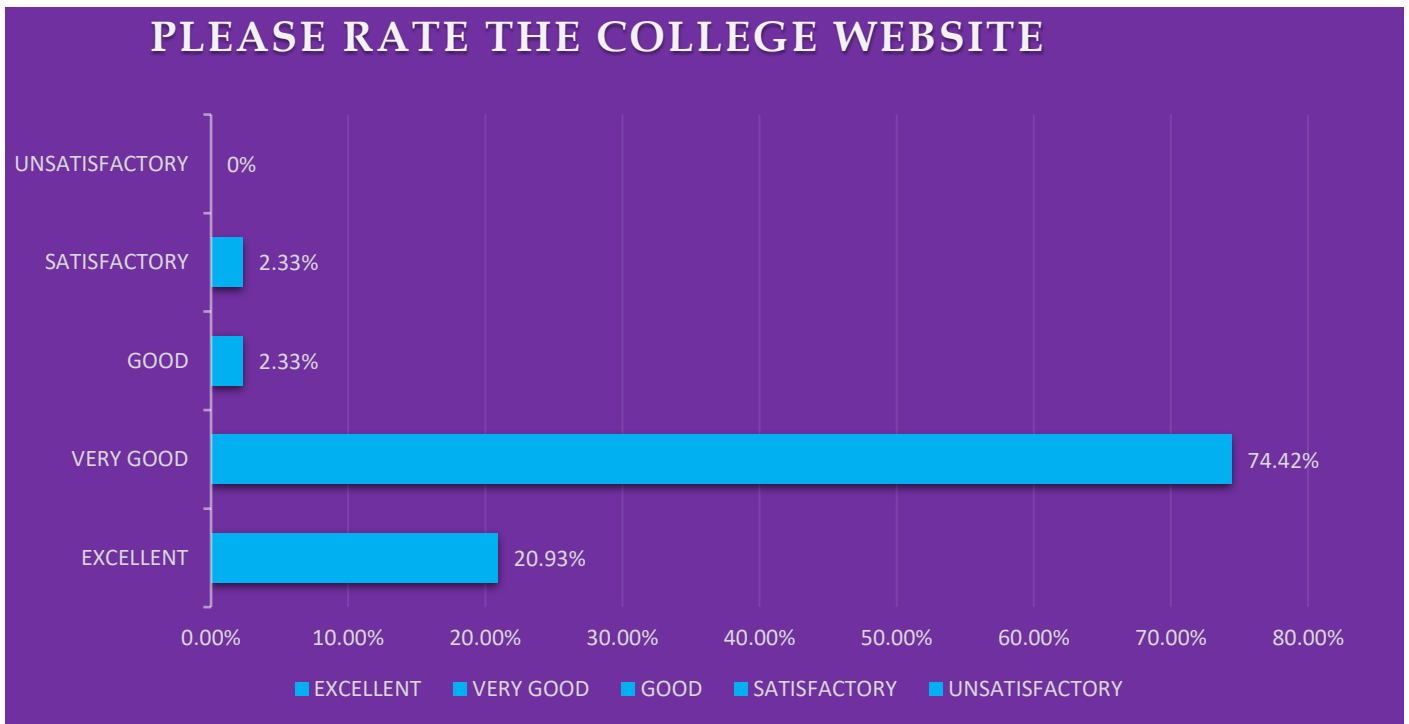
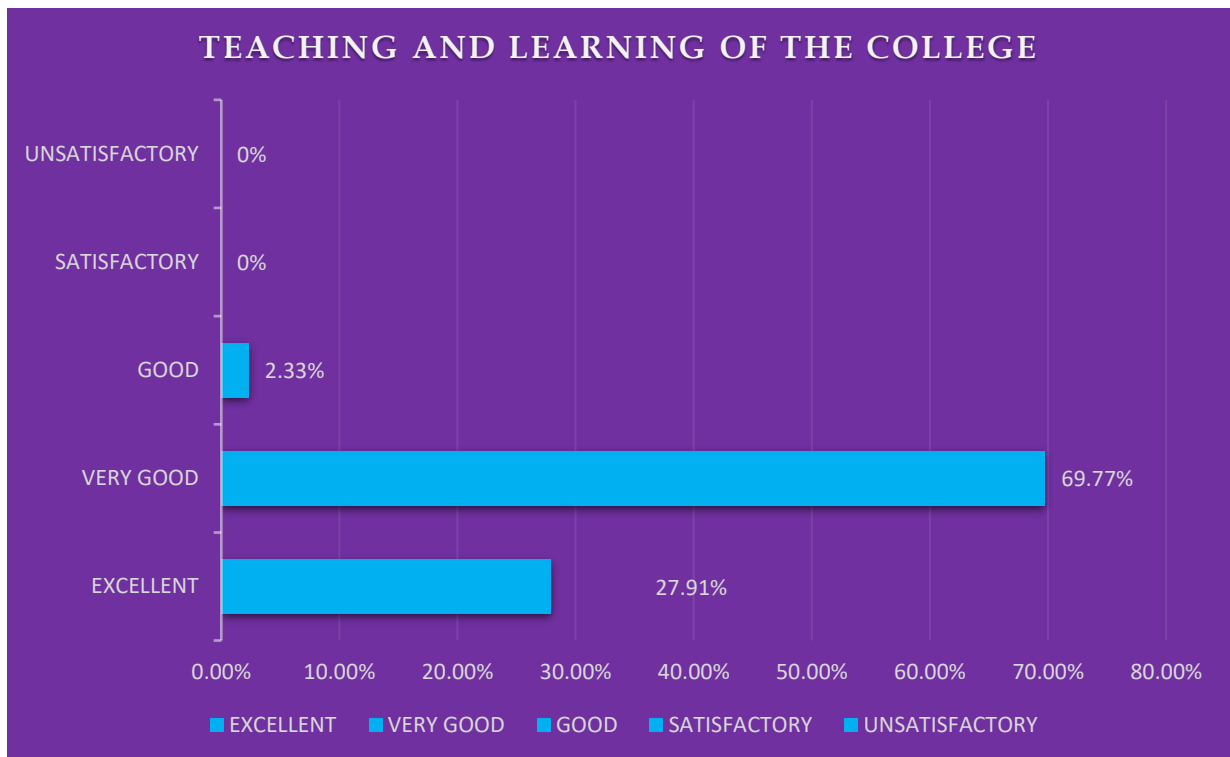


PARENT FEEDBACK: 2021-22

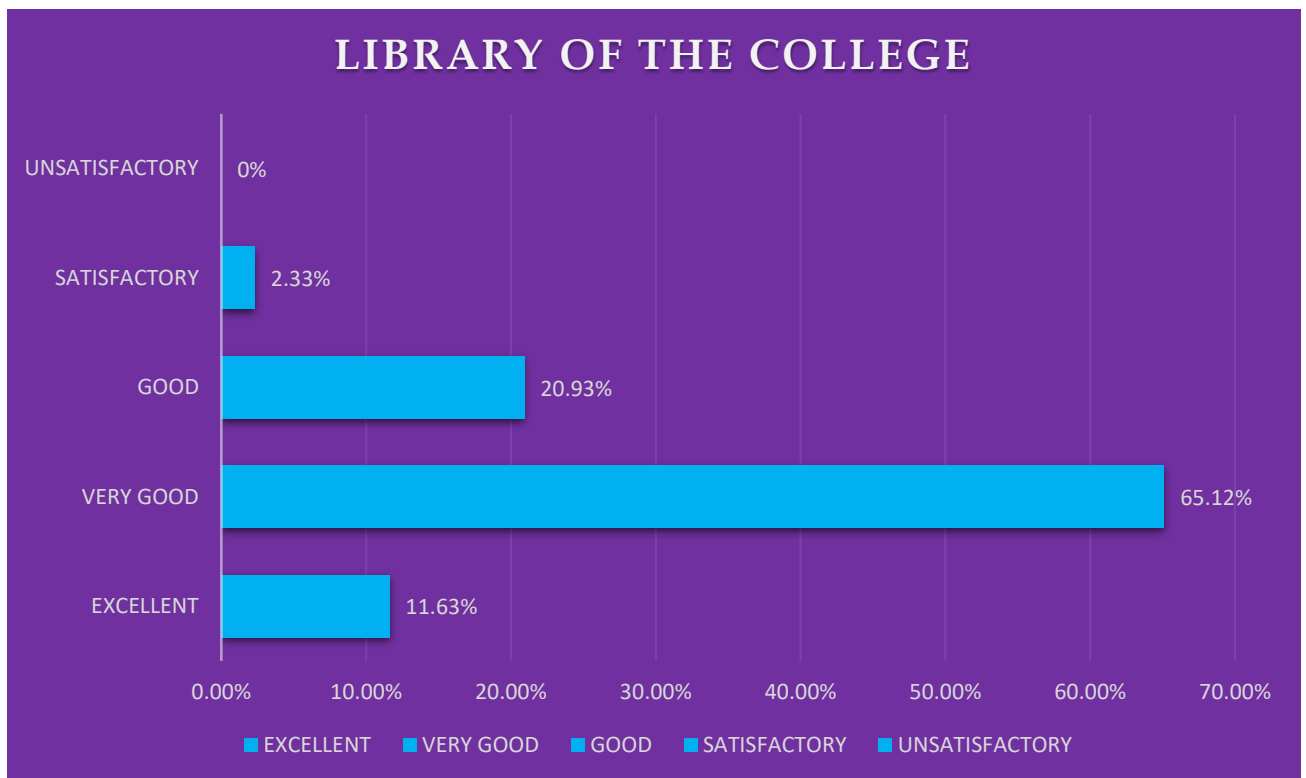
**“THE COLLEGE WEBSITE”**

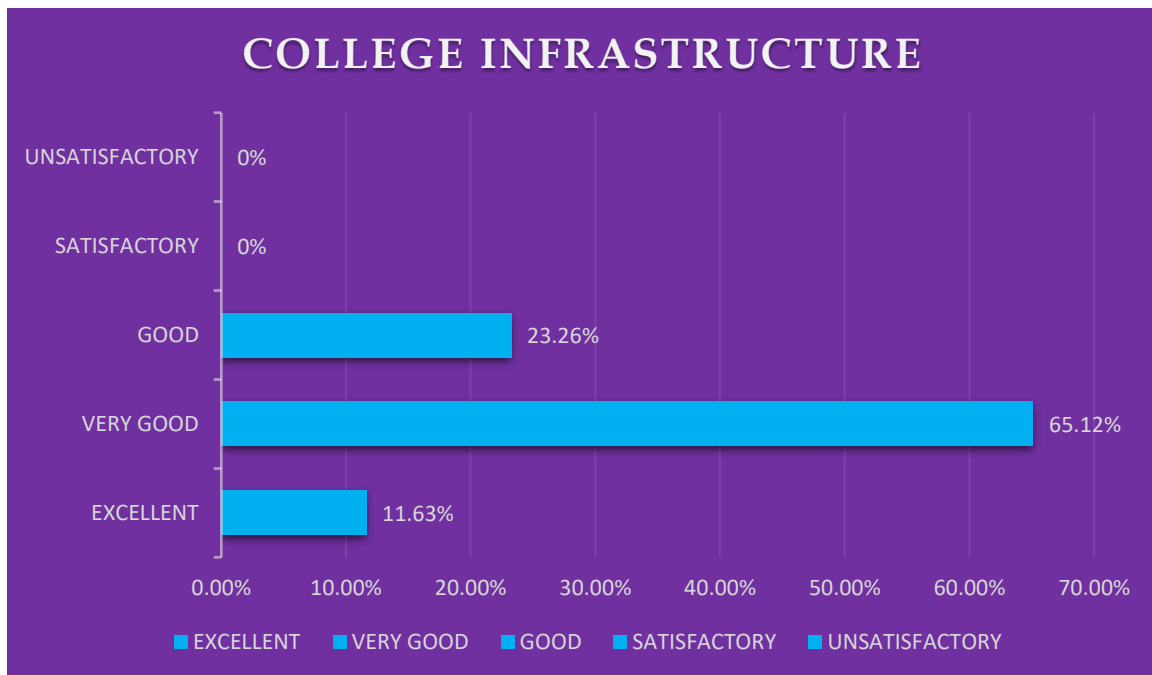
“TEACHING AND LEARNING OF THE COLLEGE”

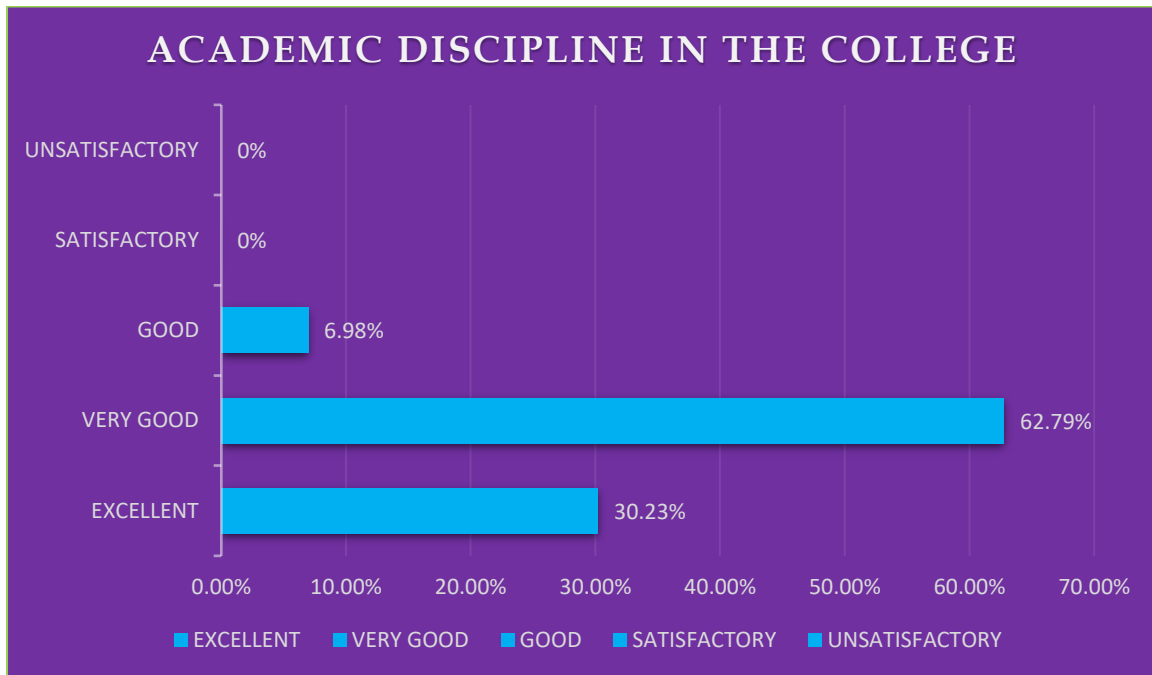
“LIBRARY OF THE COLLEGE”

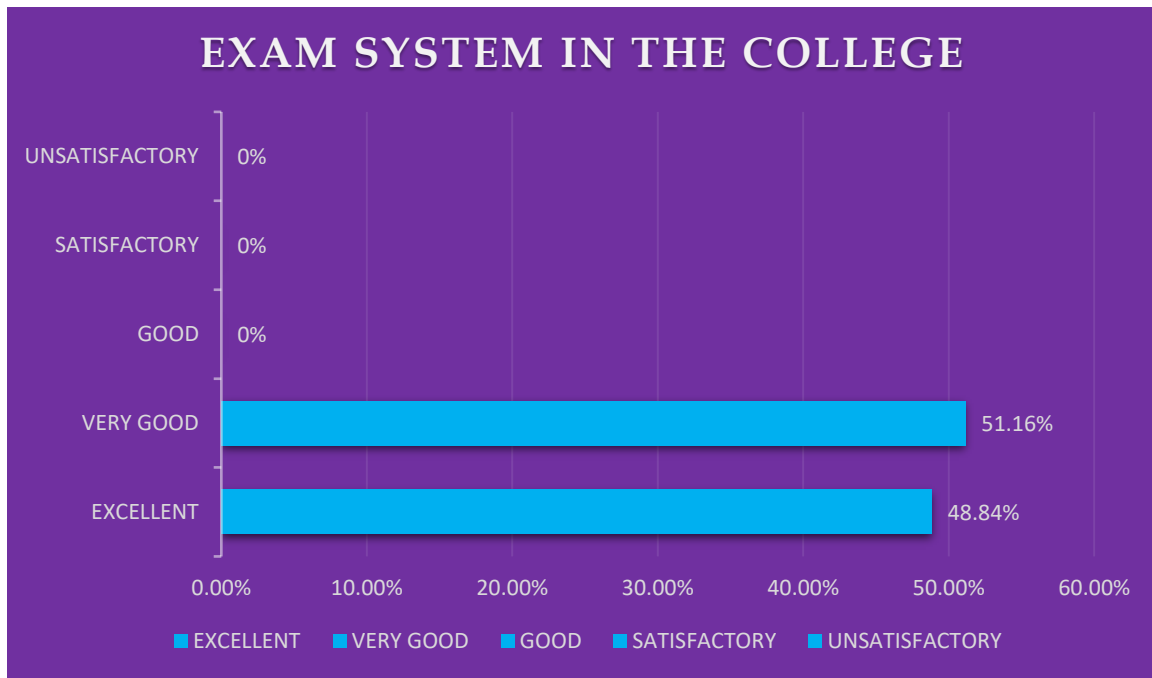
“COLLEGE INFRASTRUCTURE”

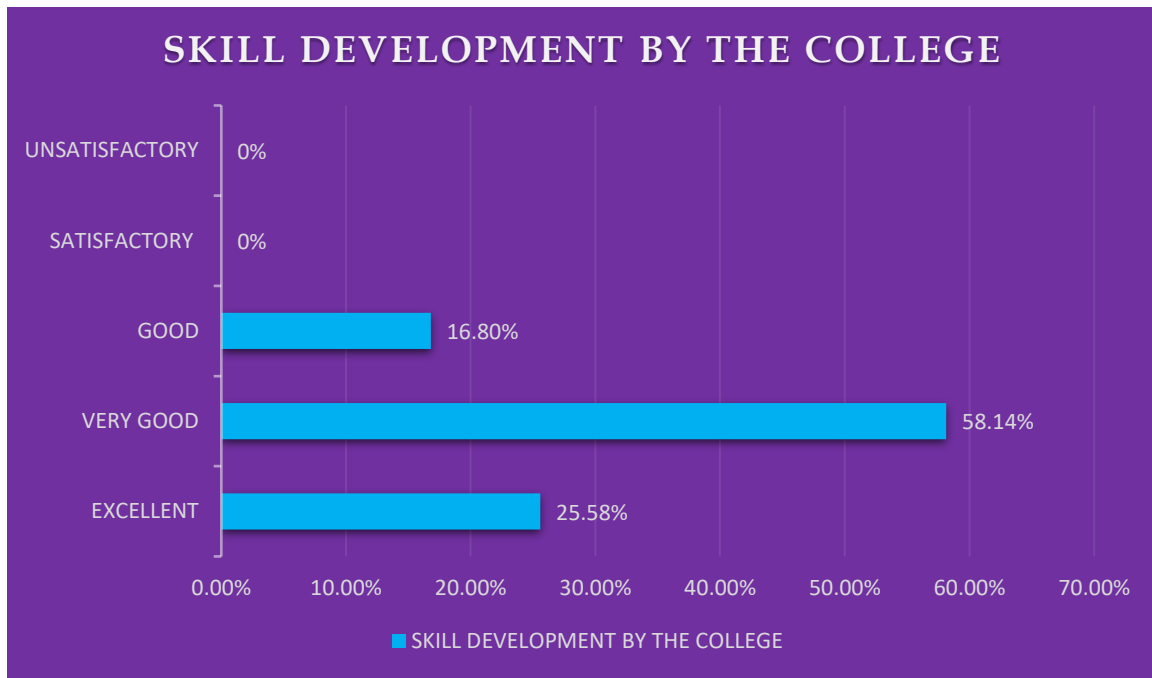
“ACADEMIC DISCIPLINE IN THE COLLEGE”

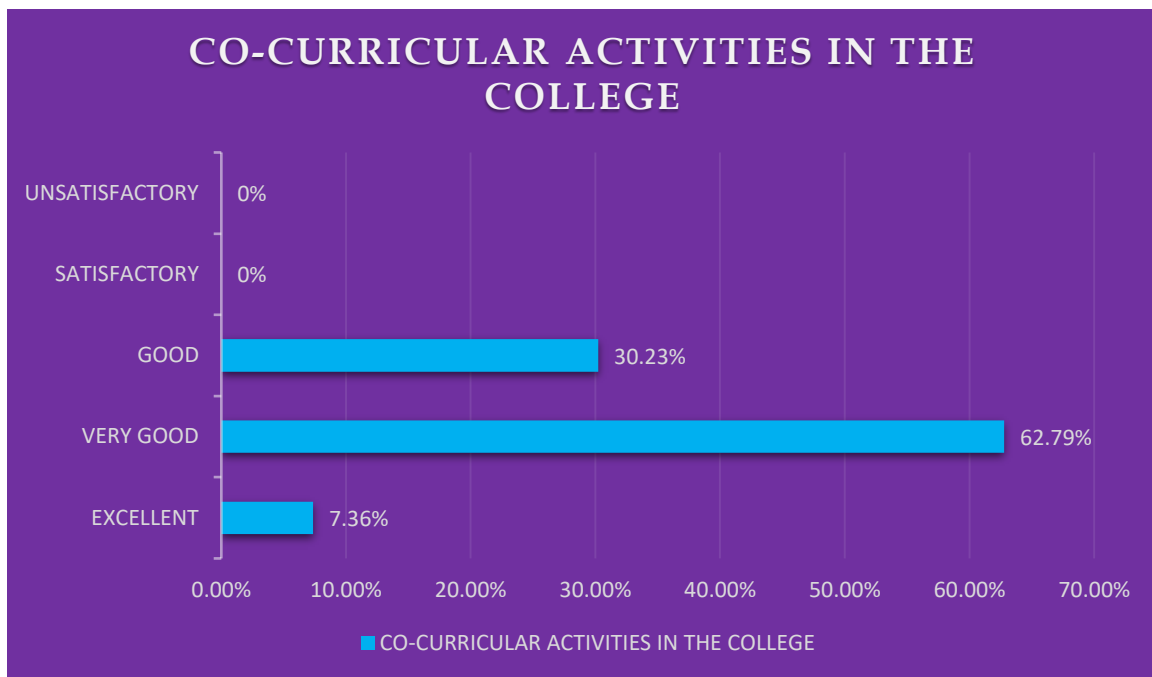
“EXAM SYSTEM IN THE COLLEGE”

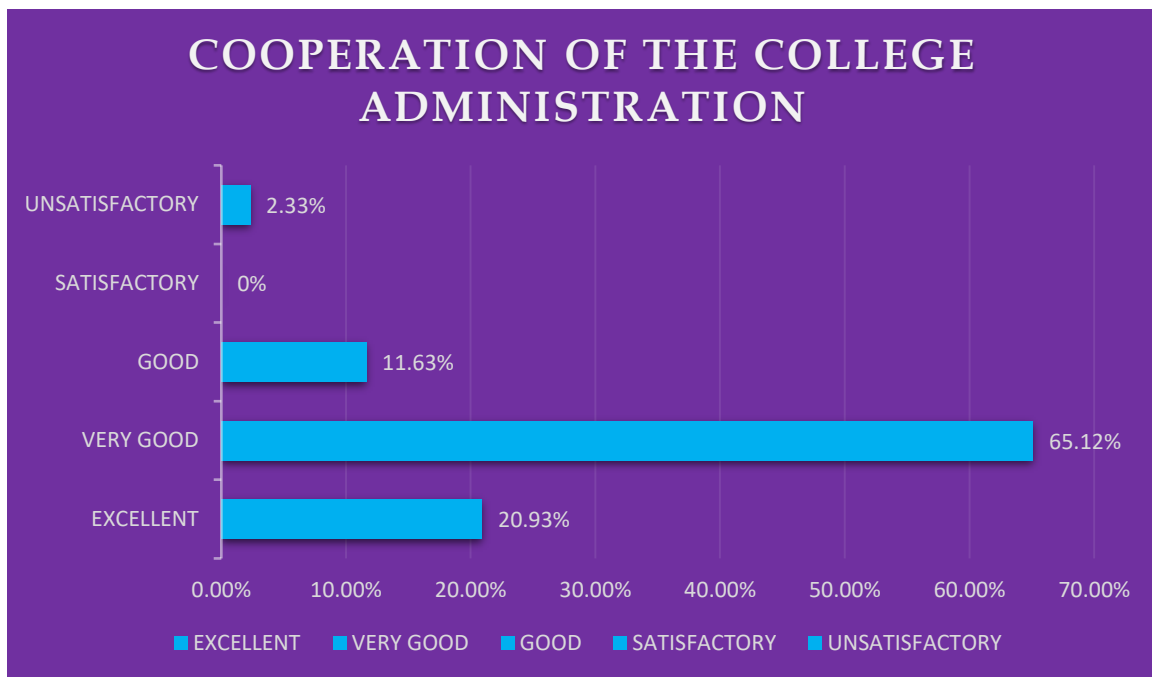
“SKILL DEVELOPMENT BY THE COLLEGE”

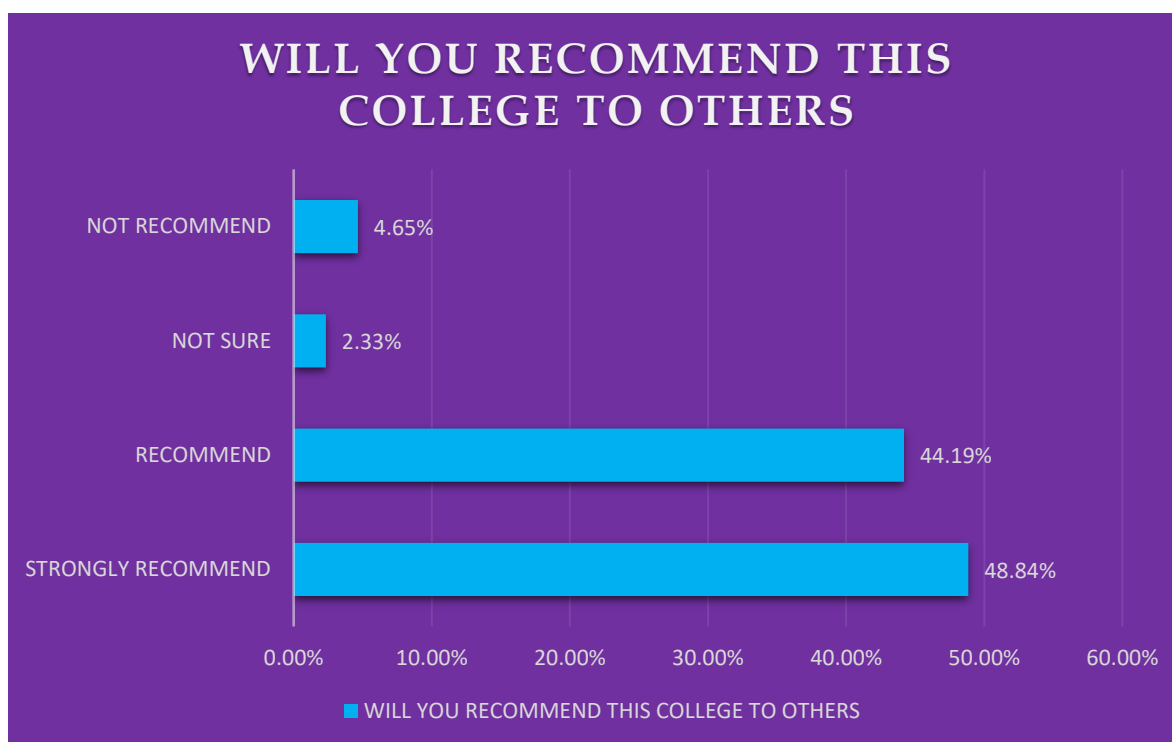
“CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES IN THE COLLEGE”

“WILL YOU RECOMMEND THIS COLLEGE TO OTHERS”

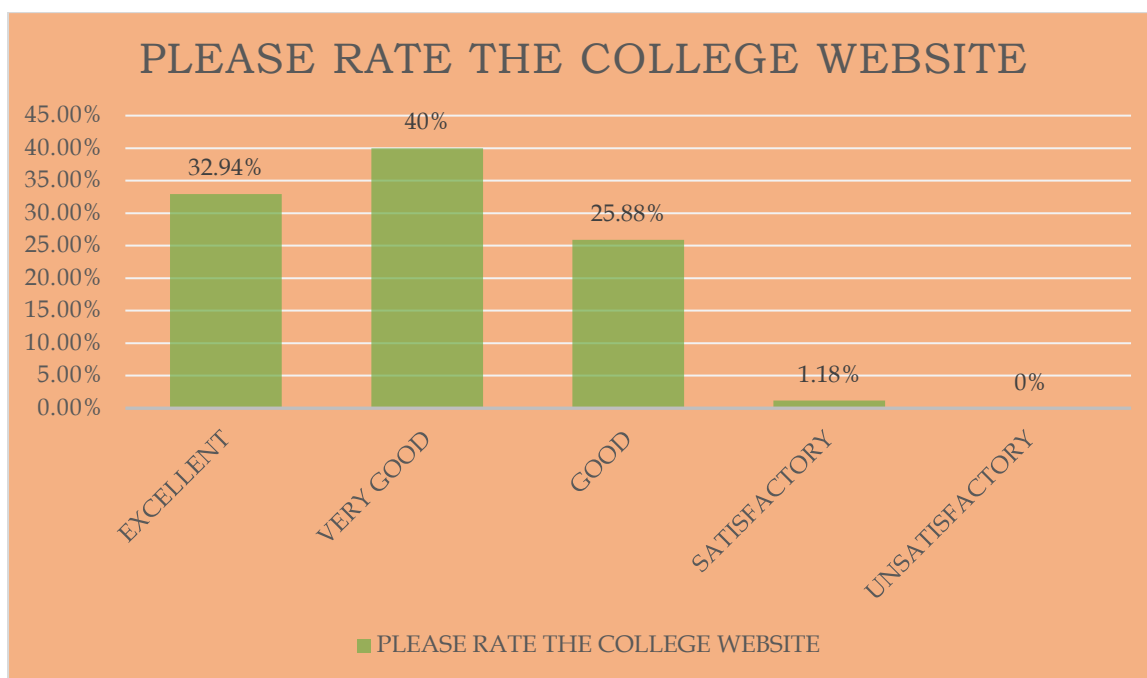

4. For annual sports GB allotted Rs 50 thousand, for Research 25 thousand, Excursion fund to be allotted.

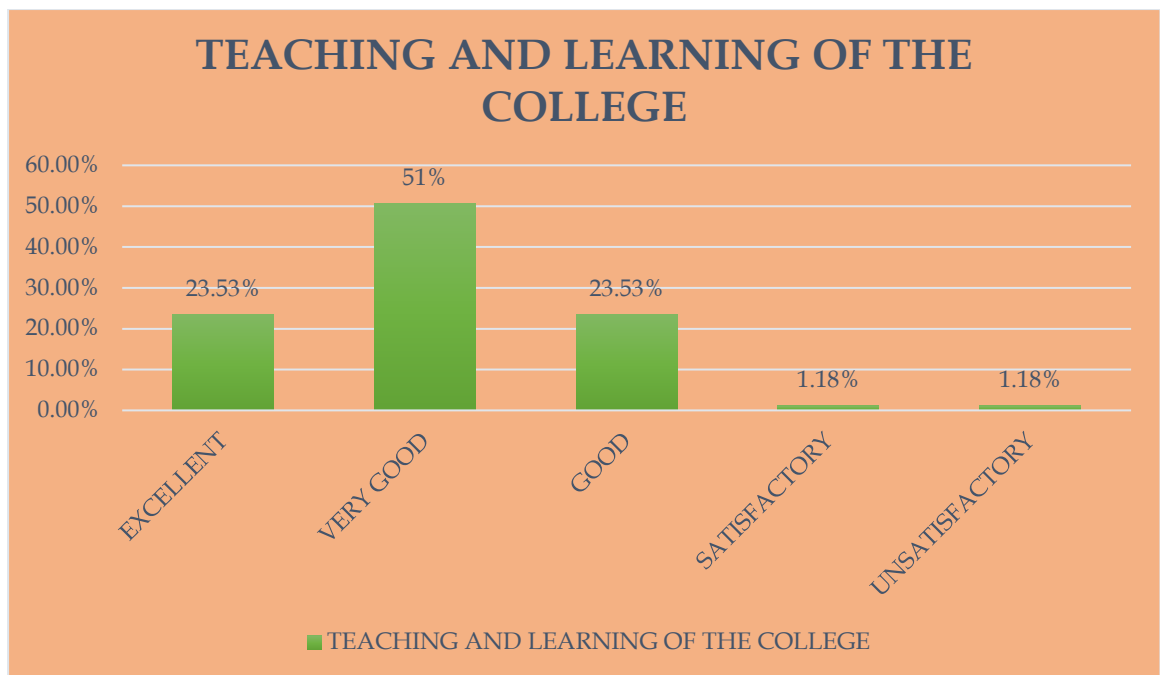

PARENT FEEDBACK ANALYSIS WITH ATR FOR THE SESSION: 2022-23



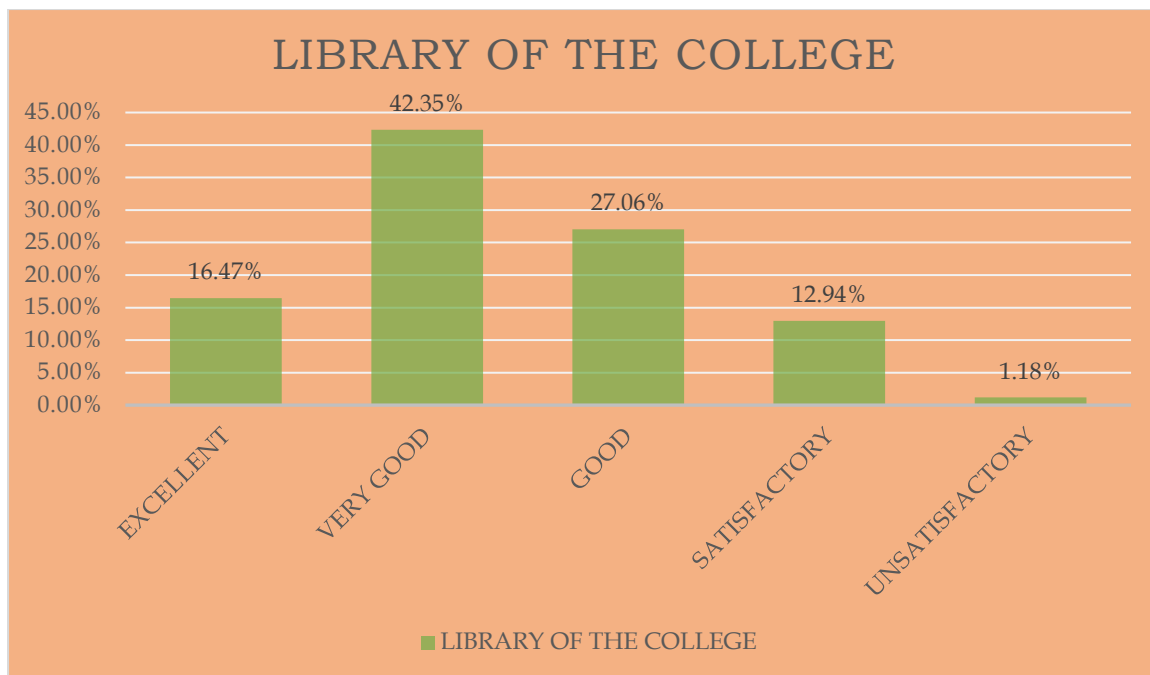
Parent Feedback on "THE COLLEGE WEBSITE"

The overall feedback is overwhelmingly positive, with over 98% of Parent rating the website as "Good" or better. The college website seems to meet or exceed the expectations of most users. The minimal "Satisfactory" ratings suggest a very small group of users may have experienced minor issues or have higher expectations. 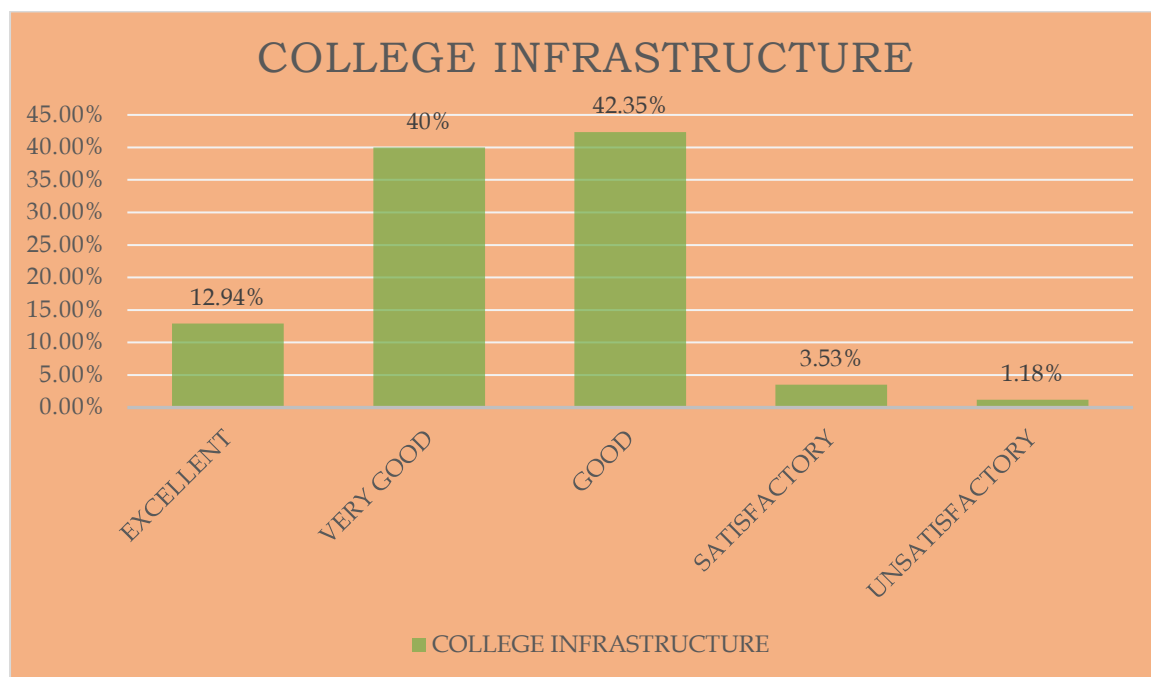
Parent Feedback on "TEACHING AND LEARNING OF THE COLLEGE"

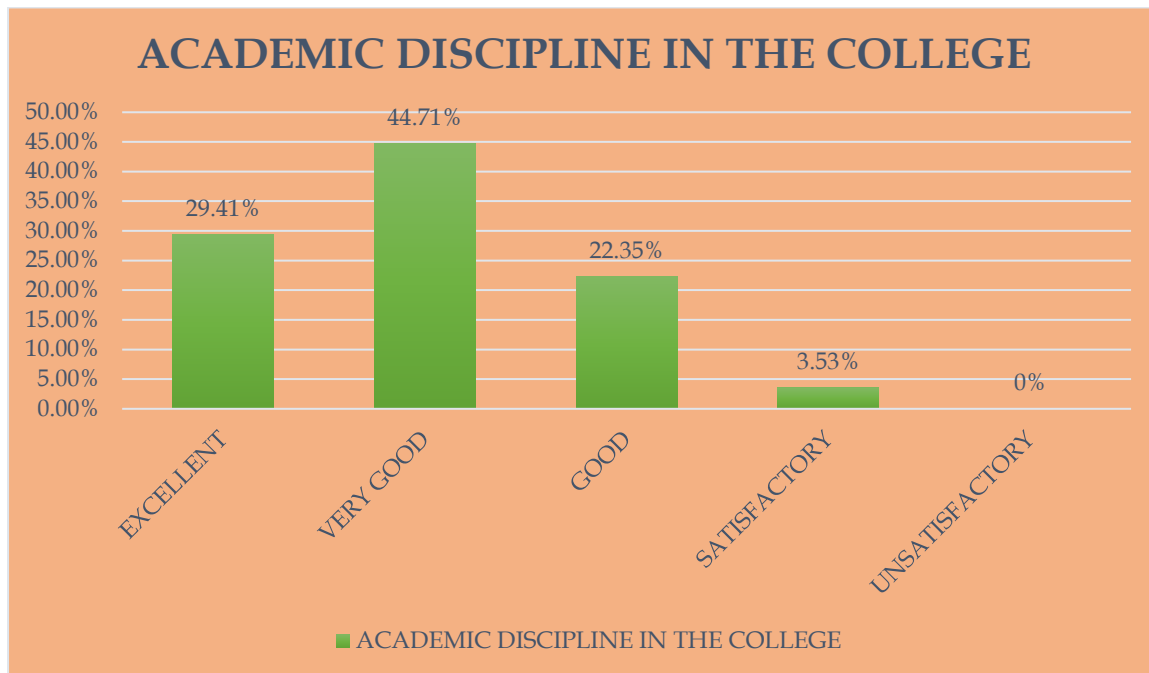
Parent Feedback on "LIBRARY OF THE COLLEGE"

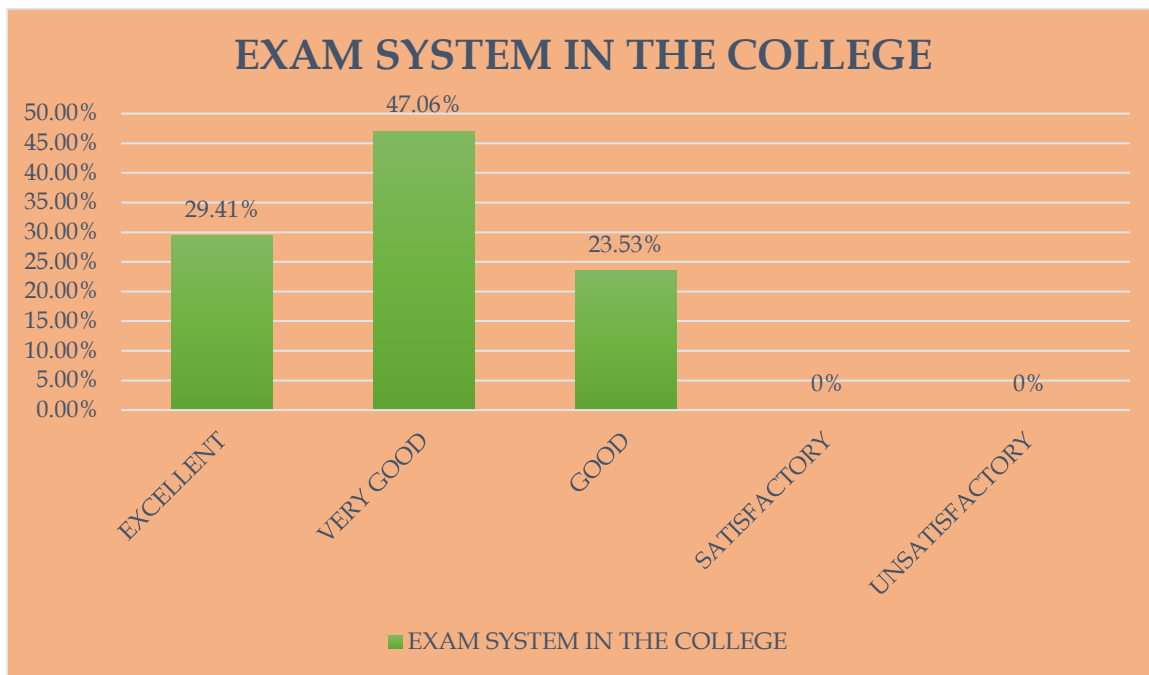
Parent Feedback on "COLLEGE INFRASTRUCTURE "

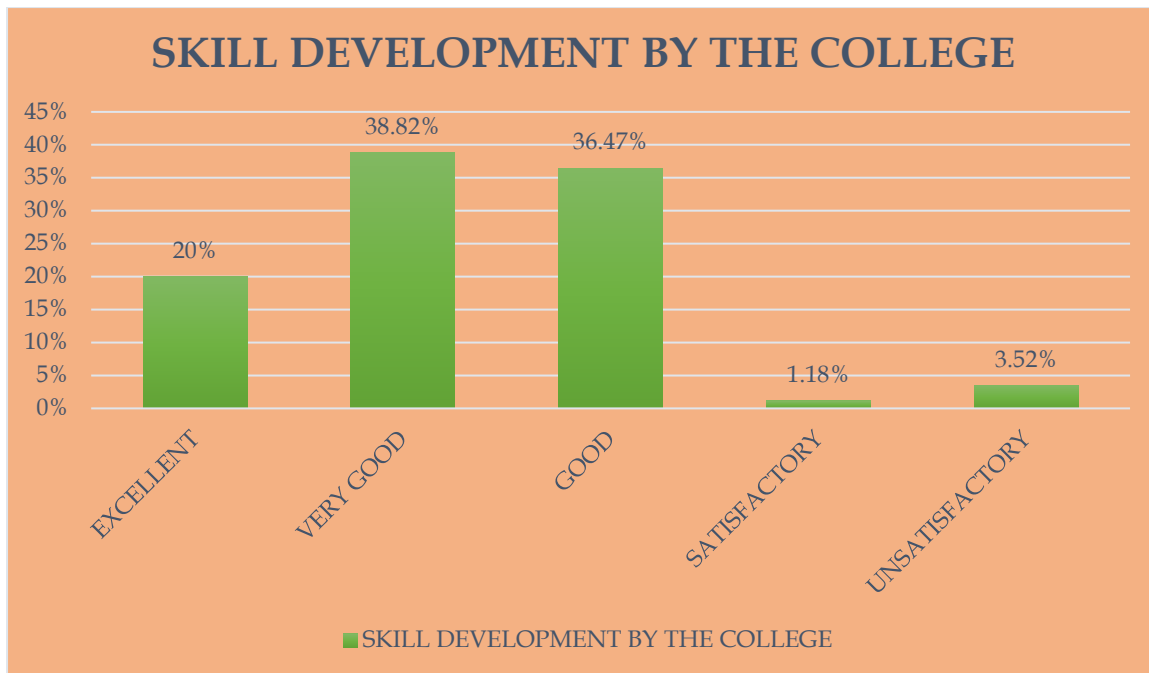
Parent Feedback on "ACADEMIC DISCIPLINE IN THE COLLEGE"

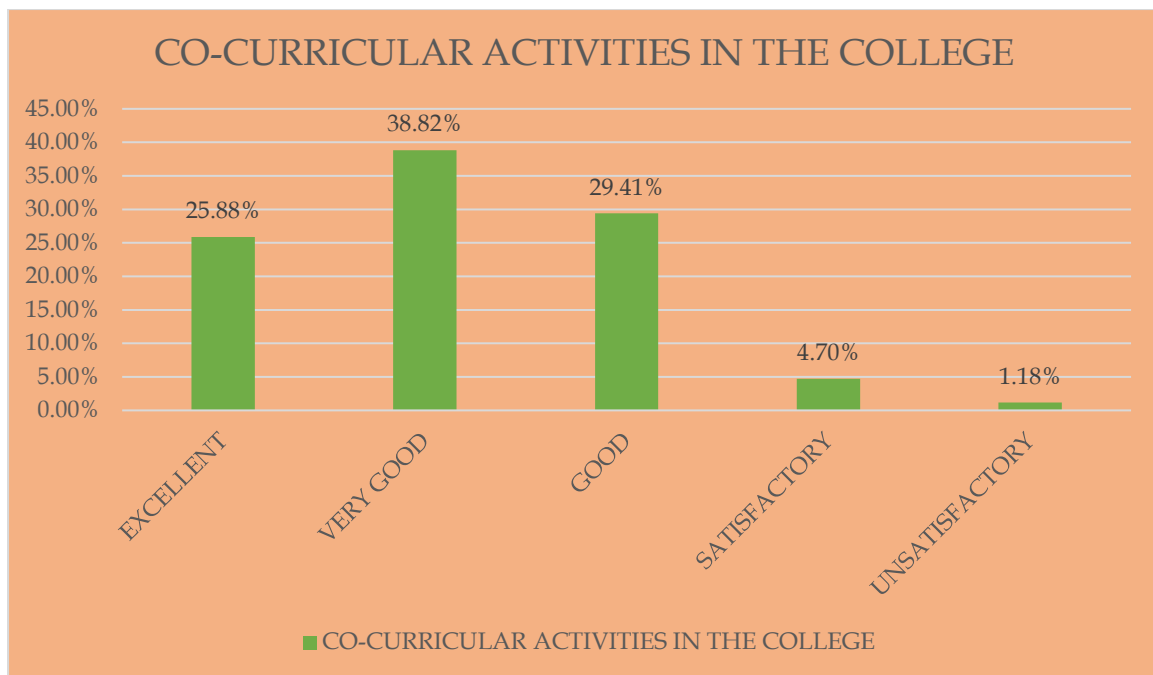
Parent Feedback on "EXAM SYSTEM IN THE COLLEGE"

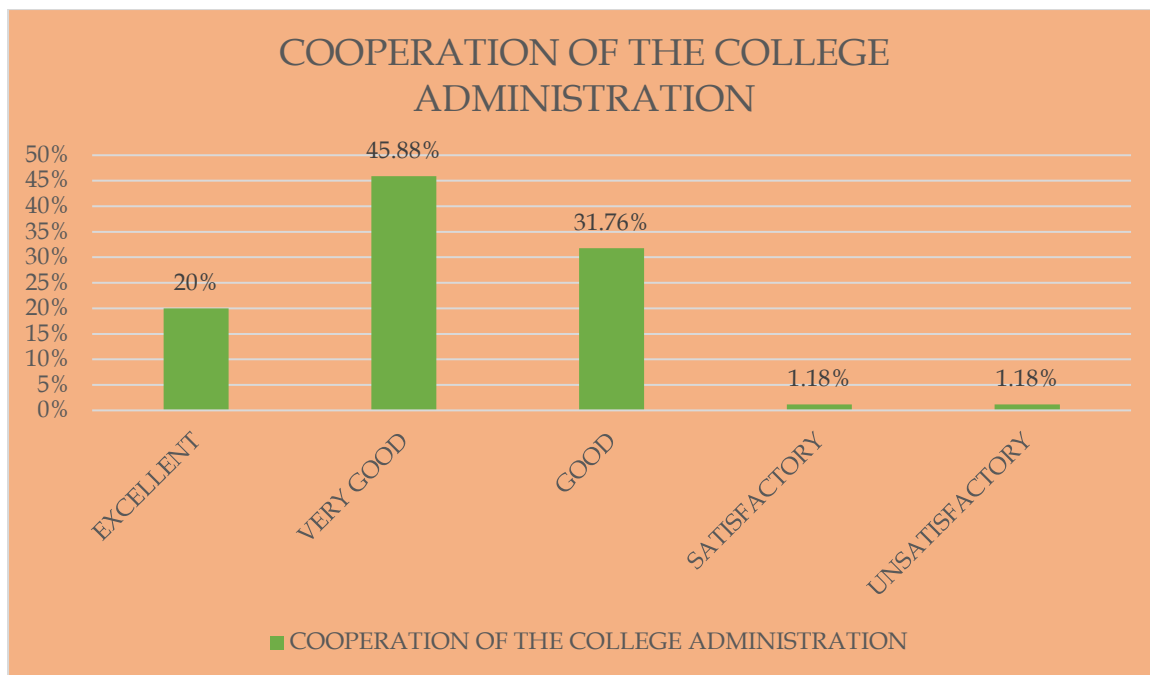
Parent Feedback on "SKILL DEVELOPMENT BY THE COLLEGE"

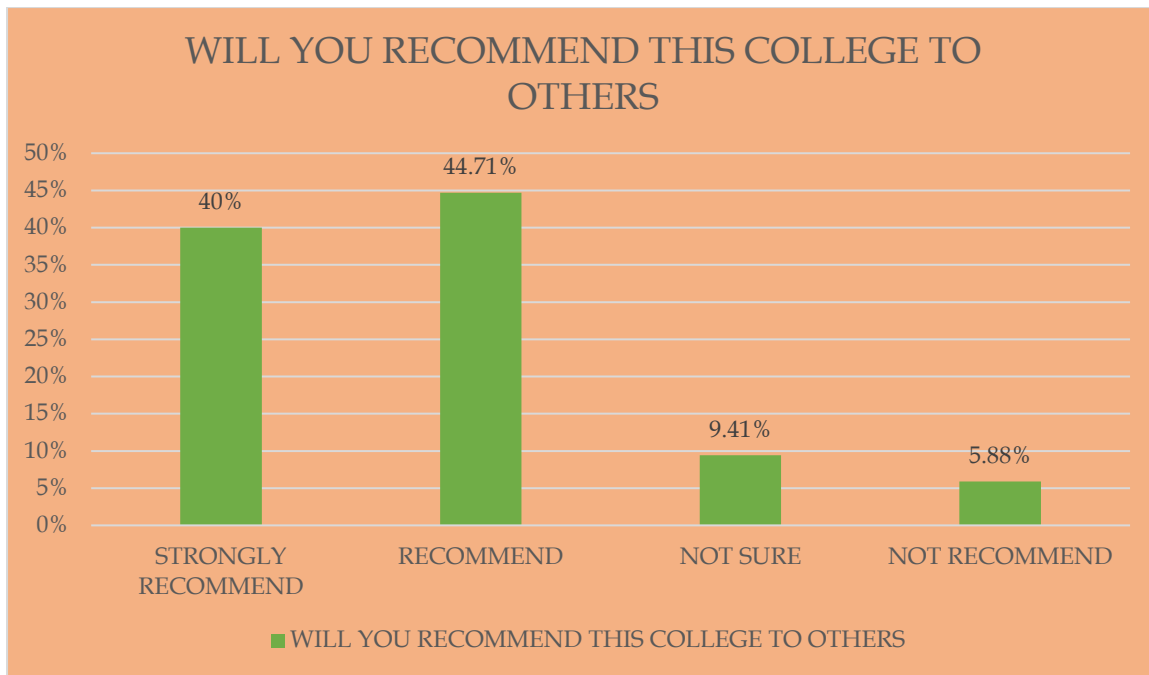
Parent feedback on "CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES IN THE COLLEGE"

The small percentages of satisfactory and unsatisfactory ratings could indicate some areas where the college administration can focus on improving their cooperation with parents.



Parent feedback on “WILL YOU RECOMMEND THIS COLLEGE TO OTHERS”

The combined percentage of strongly recommend and recommend responses (84.71%) reflects a significant majority of respondents who have a positive view of the college and would recommend it to others. This indicates a generally good reputation and satisfaction level among parents. Though the positive recommendation rate is high, the percentage of respondents who are not sure or would not recommend the college (15.29% - sum of not sure and not recommend) suggests areas where the college needs to increase confidence and satisfaction among parents.
