NOTICE

Subject: Notice regarding Exit Option from Undergraduate Programme after Semester II, IV and VI

In accordance with the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) issued by the Department of Controller of Examinations, The University of Burdwan, dated 11.06.2026, students intending to avail themselves of the exit option from the Undergraduate Programme after completion of Semester II, Semester IV, or Semester VI are hereby informed to submit their applications to the College Office within the stipulated period.

Students are advised to carefully note the following provisions:

- 1. Exit after Semester II:** A student completing 40 credits may opt to exit and shall be eligible for the award of UG Certificate, subject to successful completion of the prescribed 4-credit Skill Based Vocational Course carrying 50 marks (Theory – 30, Practical – 20).
- 2. Exit after Semester IV:** A student completing 87 credits may opt to exit and shall be eligible for the award of UG Diploma, subject to successful completion of the prescribed 4-credit Skill-Based Vocational Course carrying 50 marks (Theory – 30, Practical – 20).
- 3. Exit after Semester VI:** Students enrolled in the 4-Year Honours Programme who successfully complete 128 credits may opt to exit after Semester VI and shall be eligible for the award of UG Degree. Such students are required to exercise the exit option while filling up the examination form for the Semester VI Examination.

4. The additional credits obtained through the Skill-Based Vocational Course, wherever applicable, shall not be considered for computation of SGPA/CGPA, although they shall be reflected in the Grade Card.

5. Students opting for exit should carefully consider the academic consequences and re-entry provisions prescribed by the University. Re-entry provisions are available subject to the conditions and maximum programme duration stipulated by the University.

6. Students intending to avail the exit option are required to submit their application in plain paper to the College Office on or before 30.09.2026. Incomplete or delayed applications shall not be entertained.

7. Students are advised to consult their Departmental Mentors/Teachers/Counselors' before submitting their applications so that they are fully aware of the academic implications of exercising the exit option.

8. The College shall verify the student's credits earned, completion/enrolment of the mandatory Skill-Based Vocational Course wherever applicable, examination results and clearance of institutional dues before forwarding the eligible cases to the University.

Students concerned are therefore requested to take note of the above provisions and complete the necessary formalities within the prescribed time.
